My name is Richard I. Mack, and I am a retired Police Officer and Sheriff, having served in Law Enforcement for twenty years. Fifteen of those were served in leadership and public administration. In my role as the elected Sheriff of Graham County Sheriff in Arizona, I became the first sheriff in American history to launch a major lawsuit against the Federal Government, take it all the way to the U S Supreme Court, and win a landmark ruling for States' Rights and the autonomy of local police and sheriffs.

In 2011 I founded the Constitutional Sheriffs & Peace Officers Association (CSPOA). The CSPOA mission is to promote Civil Rights and Liberty for all people. We train all peace officers to uphold and defend the God-given rights of all people. We denounce and condemn all violence and corruption.

During the past seven years I have worked extensively with Daniel Gaumont Page to form a CSPOA in Quebec. He helped us organize five webinars in which we conducted training for police and citizens alike to help promote the goals of our organization in the Quebec area.

Page has a great deal of compassion for all humankind, and he has done a great deal of research regarding the efficacy of Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy. I know he is sincerely trying to help people with Cerebral Palsy and Autism.

Even though Daniel is not a certified Sheriff or Peace Officer, we have lots of citizens and former police who work with us as we attempt to bring all parties together for peaceful solutions. Daniel is a bona fide member of our association, and his work has been very worthwhile.

I was very shocked and taken aback that Daniel was charged criminally for impersonating a police officer. He is blind and it is obvious that he could not be a police officer. It did not appear to me that his rights as a disabled citizen were respected. Incarcerating a blind man for such criminal charges seems unjust and outrageous.

I salute Daniel Gaumont Page for his courage in standing for the constitutional rights of the people of Quebec and for his dedication to protect disabled children. I stand with him and against the criminal charges that put him in prison.
